Please use this form to request landscaping changes in your front yard. The HOA is responsible for the maintenance of the front yards and community areas and we want these areas to look neat and attractive and coordinated.

If you have a dead plant in your front yard, the HOA will pay to have it cut down. The Landscaping Committee has the authority to declare a plant dead or unsightly. The HOA will also pay for your new plant (limits on number and cost will apply) and to have our landscapers plant it.

Stumps and old plant roots

If you have a stump and associated plant roots in your front yard you have a choice from these three alternatives:

- 1. Choose a ground cover from our approved plant list and we will plant it (at HOA expense)
- 2. Choose a plant or two from the approved plant list and we will plant it/them (at HOA expense)
- 3. Remove the dead plant, stump and roots (at homeowner's expense)
